**Huron Home Unit – Respiratory Outbreak**

- 6 residents are in isolation due to respiratory illness

Public Health has confirmed an outbreak on Huron Unit only, **organism is not yet determined**. Public Health continues to work with us for the duration of the outbreak.

All visitors and employees must put on a medical mask when entering the Huron Home unit.

**Outbreak Protocols:**

**Essential visitors ONLY on Huron Unit** – all people entering the Huron Unit must wear a medical mask. Please be aware and read all posted signs in the home for further direction.

**Visiting ill residents** - Please follow all posted signage when visiting an ill resident. If you have questions related to putting on and removing your PPE please ask the nurse on the unit.

**Essential Visitor Training** – if you require EV training, please contact Reception at ext. 7170 to arrange.

**Palliative Care/End of Life** – general visitors welcome however, the Charge RN must approve each visitor entering the home

No crossover from unit to unit
