<b>RESIDENT LINE LIST:</b>	<b>REST HOME – 2</b>	<b>Other isolation precautions - 0</b>

<b>Staff Line List</b>	5 staff linked to outbreak	
<b>Close Contact Staff</b>	0 staff with close contact status at this time.	
<b>Covid Screening</b>	Twice Daily for all residents on the <b>REST HOME</b> . Only complete RAT test for residents who are symptomatic; repeat in 24 hours. If continues to be negative resident remains in isolation until 24-hour symptom free.	
<b>Visitors</b>	EVs who are going to visit any resident on <b>REST HOME</b> unit are to obtain a surgical mask and eye protection at the entrance to the unit. They will then don the remaining PPEs at the entrance to the resident room if in isolation status. 6 EV for each resident maximum allowed at one time and no general visitors allowed. No visiting with other residents. Infection control tip sheet available at the desk for <b>REST HOME</b> EV.	
<b>Risk Mitigation</b>	Potential close contact residents are being socially distanced in the dining room areas. Please encourage close contacts to wear a mask and stay socially distanced. Staffing D & E with 1 extra staff	
<b>Recreation</b>	No cross over into the Nursing Home. No Large Group programming in the Rest Home.	
<b>Appointments/LOA</b>	No LOA's for REST Home resident, except necessary medical, compassionate leaves	
<b>Resident Meal Service</b>	Meal Assistance schedule sent out to admin staff, admin staff will continue to assist with meals during the week.	
<b>PPE</b>	<b>REST HOME: Staff - Eye protection on resident home area required at all times and fitted N95 mask.</b> Full PPE required in isolation rooms – Enhanced Precautions. Ensure proper doffing and hand hygiene when leaving the unit for breaks.	
<b>Admissions</b>	Admissions will stop in the <b>Rest Home</b> .	
<b>Smoking</b>	Rest Home Residents may continue to smoke outside.	
<b>BSO/SW/RD/PT/NURSING REHAB/HAIRDRESSING</b>	Residents can still participate with PT/BSO/SW/Nursing Rehab etc. in the Rest Home – ill residents are isolated to their room.	
<b>Laundry</b>	Continue per normal process – isolation room bins are in orange bags and require PPE when doing their laundry.	
<b>Staff Break</b>	Continues per normal process.	

Any symptomatic residents are isolated to their rooms/as well as roommate. Isolated residents may go out for exercise but must mask upon leaving their room and entering the general areas of the Home.
